Verizon has a broader coverage area than AT&T, but AT&T plans include rollover minutes. These minutes can accumulate for up to twelve months. Whenever you would go over your monthly minutes, the minutes would be deducted from your rollover minutes you have accumulated. The monthly data charge and monthly phone insurance charge are less costly through AT&T.

Comparing these two cell phone providers, I believe AT&T is the best recommendation.
